## Pro-Am Pre-Qualifier Competition Guidelines

6th & 7th July 2020

## Information Guidelines

The next JP McManus Pro-Am will be held in Adare Manor on Monday 6th & Tuesday 7th July 2020.

### PRE-QUALIFICATION

Charitable groups in the Mid-West who wish to enter must hold pre-qualifier golf competitions from April 2018 to April 2020 inclusive.

- Each Pre-Qualifier Competition to be held as a Singles Stableford Competition. Individuals can play with whom they wish on the timesheet but scoring is on a Singles Stableford basis.
- Following the conclusion of each Singles Competition, teams of three from all the returned cards will be picked at random at an open draw and the team/teams thus picked with the highest cumulative total based on two scores to count at each hole will go forward to the Grand Qualifier provided that the charitable competition has raised the required €12,500 from the staging of their event.
- Handicap limits to apply for Pre-Qualifier Competitions: Men 18, Ladies 24. Maximum handicaps of 18 for both men and ladies will apply for the Grand Qualifier and the Pro Am itself.



- Each player must present an official GUI/ILGU or a Certificate of a current handicap from their home club on the day of competition.
- Age Limit: Participants must be 20 years as of the 1/1/2018.
- The Pro-Am Committee will provide the 1st, 2nd and 3rd individual prizes for each competition. Thereafter, additional prizes are at the discretion of each organising group.
- Every €12,500 raised\* by a charitable organisation per Competition will equate to one team going forward to the Grand Qualifier on Thursday May 28th & Friday May 29th 2020. Multiples of €12,500 raised will result in additional teams qualifying.
- A specially designed software package operated by a nominee of the Pro-Am committee will conduct the random selection process. All scorecards will be returned to a player's home club.
- In the event of a chosen team member from a competition being unable to take his/her place in the Grand Qualifier, the highest scoring player from that particular event, not already on a qualifying team will be the replacement and will retain his/her place if the team progresses. A player who has already qualified from a previous competition will be flagged, as a person cannot qualify to play on two teams in the Grand Qualifier.
- Each charitable organisation is to charge a minimum entry fee of €100 per player and participation will entitle a player to a Pro-Am entrance cap valued at €100 which is fully transferable and will entitle the bearer spectator entry to the Pro-Am at Adare Manor over the two days of 6th & 7th July 2020.
- All decisions made are at the discretion of the Pro-Am organising committee and such decisions will be final.
- A minimum of 21 days notice must be given to the Pro-Am committee about the staging of a Pre-Qualifier Competition and the deadline for registration is 14/6/19.

\* €25,000 raised equates to two teams going forward. However a portion of €12,500 will not qualify a team for the Grand Qualifier.
